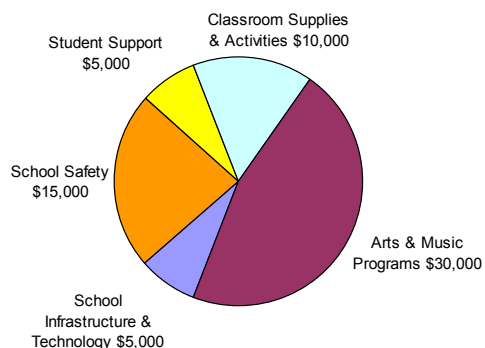


## Support through Fundraising
