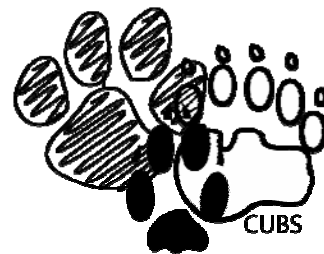

School Uniforms:

Report Card information, grade K-5:

STUDENT REPORT CARDS CAME HOME WITH THE STUDENTS ON Friday, December 1. If your child did not bring home a report card, please contact your child's teacher as soon as possible. You keep the copy of the report card and return the envelope that the report card came in. If your child has any "1" in any area, *you need to be concerned*. Make sure that you and the teacher have a plan developed so that your child can make acceptable progress to grade level standards.

Open Enrollment 2007:

Attention all families interested in Open Enrollment for the 2007-08 School Year: There has been a change!!

In past years, only students applying for grades 1-12 and Kindergarten Open Enrollment for Washington Open or Millikin Basics+ applied in January. Effective January 2007, Kindergarten Open Enrollment for ALL Schools will occur between January 8 – February 2, 2007. Visit the district website, www.scusd.net, for detailed instructions on how to proceed.

Kindergarten Registration 2007:

Kindergarten Registration for all 2007 incoming Kindergarten students will begin January 8th, 2007. Parents are encouraged to register their incoming Kindergarten student January 8th – February 2nd. Parents must bring Proof of Residency, in the form of a PG&E or Santa Clara Utility bill or a current rental agreement if the utilities are not held in the parent's name and current immunization records. Most Kindergarten students will not have immunizations completed by this date; however records will be accepted later in the spring as well as in August during the opening of school.

Yearbook Announcement:

Callejon Cubs, now is your chance to order the first ever, Don Callejon Cubs yearbook for 2007. This book will be in full color and full of memories of this first year in our new school.

Books ordered by December 19th are \$35.⁰⁰. After December 19th the cost increases to \$40.

A \$5.⁰⁰ deposit payment by December 19th reserves your \$35.⁰⁰ copy for June 2007. Installment payments may be made over the next two months. Final installment payments must be made by March 15th (the Ides of March!).

Grades K – 5, your teachers will give you the order forms. Return those with payment to your teacher. They will give them to Mrs. Hathaway. Middle School students, turn in your order forms and payments to Araceli in the Office or to Mrs. Hathaway in Room E7 or E5.

Parents – you may contact the office if you need an order form.

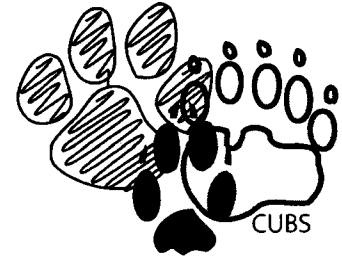

Dear Don Callejon Parent/Guardian,

We are going to begin the process of looking into school uniforms for Don Callejon School for the 2007-2008 school year and beyond.

According to SCUSD board policy 5259, "These rationale have been cited in support of uniforms.

- Uniforms place all students on equal footing.
- Uniforms remind students of the seriousness of their work at school.
- Uniforms create increased sense of camaraderie and spirit on campus.
- Uniforms could reduce family's cost of school clothes.
- Uniforms lead to improved student behavior."

The board policy outlines the procedures necessary to investigate school uniforms.

1. The principal indicates in writing that the school is interested in beginning the process.
2. The principal forms a school planning committee.
3. The school holds a minimum of two informational meetings at times convenient to parents.
4. Ballots are distributed to all staff and families. Before a school may require uniforms, 100% of families must be notified; 70% or more of the families must support school uniforms.
5. Results of the ballots are tabulated and publicized.
6. The school planning committee determines the implementation guidelines.
7. The principal communicates in writing to the parents and students how the uniforms will be implemented.
8. The school evaluates at the end of the year for the first three years of the program.

We invite parents to be a part of our school planning committee. We will hold our first meeting on Wednesday, December 13 at 6:00 PM at Don Callejon School. After this committee is formed, we will then hold our two informational meetings in 2007. Students will be invited to attend these meetings. We will also publicize all of our research and findings on the Don Callejon School website (www.doncallejon.org).

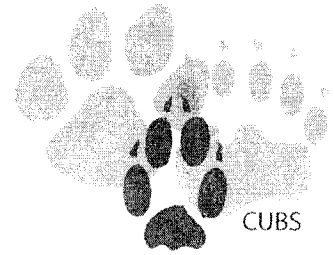

Estimados padres de estudiantes,

Vamos a iniciar el proceso del uso de uniformes en la escuela Don Callejon a partir del año escolar 2007-2008.

Según la poliza de la mesa directiva 5259 de SCUSD, "La conclusión del análisis del uso de uniformes son las siguientes:

- Uniformes dan el sentido de igualdad a todos los estudiantes.
- Uniformes recuerdan a los estudiantes la seriedad de su trabajo en la escuela.
- Uniformes crean el sentido de camaradería y espíritu estudiantil en el plantel escolar.
- Uniformes pueden reducir el coste a la familia de ropa para la escuela.
- Uniformes mejoran el comportamiento de los estudiantes."

La poliza de la mesa planea los procedimientos necesarios para investigar el uso de uniformes.

1. El director/a indica por escrito que la escuela está interesada en comenzar el proceso.
2. El director/a forma el comité de planeamiento para la escuela.
3. Ocasionalmente la escuela tendrá un mínimo de dos reuniones informativas a horas convenientes para los padres.
4. Las papeletas de votación se distribuyen a todo el personal y familias. Antes de que una escuela pueda requerir los uniformes, 100% de las familias deben ser notificados; el 70% o más de las familias deben apoyar los uniformes para la escuela.
5. Las papeleta de votación se tabulan y serán publicadas.
6. El comité de planeamiento de la escuela determinará las implementaciones de las normas de uso.
7. El director/a comunicará por escrito a los padres y a los estudiantes cómo los uniformes serán implementados.
8. En los primeros tres años del programa, la escuela evaluará a este programa al final de cada año.

Invitamos a los padres que sean parte de nuestro comité de planeamiento de la escuela. Tendremos nuestra primera reunión el **miércoles 13 de diciembre a las 6:00 P.M.** en la escuela de Don Callejon. Después de que se forme este comité, tendremos nuestras dos reuniones informativas en el 2007. Se invitarán a los estudiantes que asistan a estas reuniones. También publicaremos toda nuestra investigación y los resultados en la dirección electrónica del Internet (www.doncallejon.org).

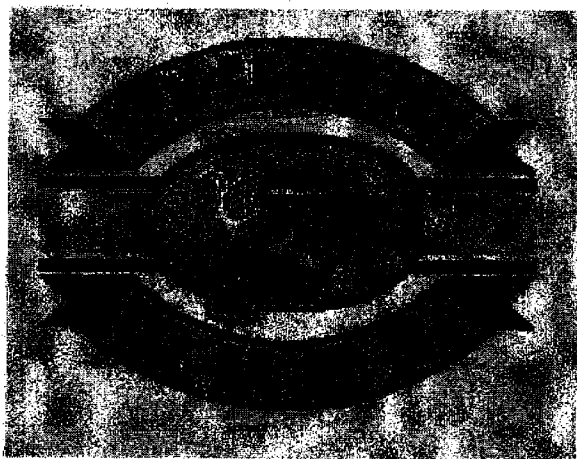
