TB Tests for Volunteers:

The District Nurses will be providing TB skin tests on April 4 (at the District Office). Per Health and Safety Code 121545, volunteers that have "frequent or prolonged contact with pupils" need to have testing or documentation that they are free communicable TB every 4 years. **The charge is \$20 for volunteers.** They are likely to be busiest early, at lunch and late.
