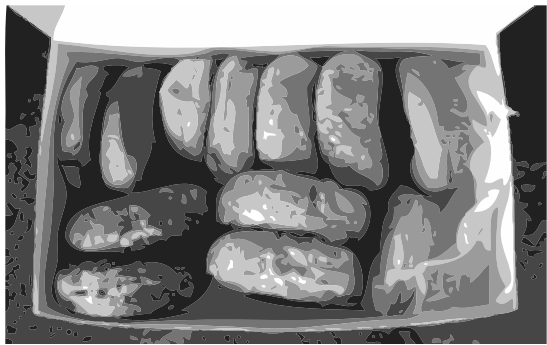
Cafeteria News:
