Open Enrollment 2010-2011

The Open Enrollment program for the 2010-11 school year will be conducted from January 7 to February 5, 2010. Parents of students wishing to attend a school other than their school of residence must first provide proof of residency to their school of residence, receive a permanent student number and then complete the Open Enrollment application on the District website @ www.santaclarausd.org. The link to the application form, school visitation dates and requirements, as well as other important information concerning this process is posted on the District website.

Students Currently Attending a District School through an Intradistrict Transfer must apply for continued enrollment at that school by completing an on-line application for Open Enrollment between January 7- February 5, 2010 if they wish to continue at that school for the 2010-11 school year.

Kindergarten Registration Update:

As you probably know, Kindergarten registration has begun for the 2010-11 school year. So far, we have registered 129 total Kindergarteners, including 39 siblings of current students. If your registration status should change, and you do not plan to attend DCS in the fall, please contact the school office ASAP. The enrollment status of each family will be communicated after February 5th.


Kindergarten Registration:






